Prayer in CM-13394-C of 2019, is for disposal of the above mentioned appeal filed by the applicant-appellant, challenging judgements and decrees dated 22.08.2013, passed by the learned Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Division), Amritsar, as well as judgement and decree dated 03.09.2015, passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Amritsar, whereby suit for specific performance by way of agreement to sell dated 26.02.2002, was decreed.

Learned counsel for the parties, submit that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties. Terms and conditions of the settlement were reduced into writing and the compromise deed dated 09.04.2019, is attached as Annexure A-1 with CM-13394-C of 2019. A sum of ₹14,50,000/-has been returned to the plaintiff-respondents and the agreement to sell dated 26.02.2002 will be treated as null and void.

Execution proceedings initiated by the respondents have been withdrawn on 11.02.2019, being satisfied.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above, specifically, the compromise deed dated 09.04.2019, CM-13394-C of 2019, is allowed and the appeal is disposed of in terms of the compromise, which needless to say, shall form part of the decree.

No orders need to be passed in any other pending application in view of the disposal of the appeal.
