Vs.

The FIR was registered on the statement of Deputy Superintendent of Police (Investigation), Patiala who on the basis of secret information informed that Sabnamdeep Singh s/o Jasvir Singh is indulged in the terrorist activities. He has formed an association with the name of K.L.F and has also associated new members in Khalistan Gaddar Force to indulge them in terrorists activities. He has got printed letter pad for release of press note under the Khalistan Liberation Force and Khalistan Gaddar Force. It was alleged that he is making plans to blast in thickly populated area which

would cause human loss. On these broad allegations, FIR was registered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and he is not named in the FIR. He further submits that his case is at par with co-accused Jatinder Singh @ Bhinder who has been granted the concession of regular bail by this Court vide order dated 24.09.2019. He submits that investigation of the case is complete and trial of the case will take time, therefore, further custody of the petitioner may not be justified.

On the other hand, learned State counsel assisted by SI Karamjit Singh opposed the prayer. However, it is not disputed that case of the petitioner is at par with co-accused-Jatinder Singh @ Bhinder. He further apprised that challan in the present case stands filed on 26.04.2019 and case is fixed for 16.12.2019 for framing of charges. It is also not disputed that the petitioner is not involved in any other case much less of the similar nature.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, this Court is of the opinion that trial of the case is likely to consume considerable time as charges are yet to be framed, therefore, further custody of the petitioner may not be justified. Resultantly, without meaning any expression of opinion on the merits of the case, it is ordered that the petitioner be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.

The petition is allowed.
