Learned State counsel, on instructions from Sh. Manoj Kumar, Assistant, office of ACS & FCR, submits that in compliance to the directions issued on 09.10.2017, an enquiry held in the matter and report given by the Additional Deputy Commissioner, Nuh and as per the said report, Sh. Nafe Singh, Tehsildar and K.K.Amrohi, DRO have been found to be negligent and action has been recommended against them. The same is pending for approval before the competent authority. He further undertakes to the needful as expeditiously as possible to bring the proceedings to a logical end.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the statement made in Court today, no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition. However, seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of surviving grievance, if any.

Disposed of with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondents is discharged.
