Though undoubtedly the allegations against the petitioner and his co-accused are unsavoury, but with the petitioner stated to be 12 years and 5 months old, as per a written certificate issued to that effect by the Head Teacher of the Government Elementary School, Karehli, as is available on the police file, and with learned counsel for the petitioner further submitting that as a matter of fact it is the elder brother with whom the actual grievance was, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, for or against the petitioner, simply looking at the age of the petitioner, he is ordered to be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned, with the impugned orders set aside.

The revision petition disposed of accordingly.
