The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.457 dated 21.06.2019, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 & 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Model Town, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and he was arraigned as an accused on the statement of co-accused, Amardeep. The allegations in the FIR are that accused Jaswinder Singh has raised the insurance claim by falsely reporting the theft of the vehicle. He also states that the petitioner is in custody for over four months and is not involved in any other case. He further contends that similarly situated co-accused, namely, Amardeep has been granted regular bail by this Court in CRM-M-40005 of 2019 on 03.10.2019.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Surender Singh, states that although investigation has been completed but the charges are yet to be framed.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over four months, he is not involved in any other case, similarly situated co-accused has been granted regular bail and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take sometime, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
