RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (ORAL):

Through this petition, the petitioner has sought for a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents/State to grant the benefit of parole to the petitioner for a period of four weeks to attend the marriage of his sister.

The case of the petitioner has been forwarded to the Commissioner, Gurugram, vide letter dated 02.11.2019 for grant of parole to attend the marriage of his sister, whose wedding is fixed for 30.11.2019 as revealed in the written statement filed by the Superintendent, District Jail, Gurugram.

It is assumed from the written statement filed by the respondents that the District Magistrate, Gurugram has already take a decision and forwarded it to the Commissioner, Gurugram, which is the procedure for grant of parole.

Since the final decision has not been taken on the application of the petitioner, the Commissioner, Gurugram Division, Gurugram-

respondent No.3, is requested to decide the representation of the petitioner within a period of 05 days, the time granted in the Haryana Government instructions dated 22.06.2018. It is expected that the Commissioner, Gurugram Division, Gurugram-respondent No.3, will take a sympathetic view looking to the tender age of the petitioner when the crime was committed and also the appeal is pending before this Court.

With the above observations, the petition stands disposed of.
