The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner claiming the benefits in respect of the service rendered by her late husband, namely, Pritam Singh, who unfortunately died on 01.07.2018. The claim of the petitioner is that not only the salary for the period her late husband worked with the respondents, has not been released but even the benefits of the service, which her late husband performed with the respondents, have not been released to her after his death. The prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to release all the benefits for which the petitioner is entitled in respect of the service rendered by her late husband with the respondent-Nigam.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief, which has been claimed in the present writ petition, petitioner has served

the respondents with a legal notice dated 30.05.2019 (Annexure P-8), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and the claim being made by the petitioner, the respondents are directed to decide the legal notice dated 30.05.2019 (Annexure P-8) by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
