Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing of the FIR No.75 dated 05.04.2016 registered under Section 3 of Schedule Castes and Schedule Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities Act), 1989 at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib, Punjab.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that the prosecution has examined almost all the witnesses. She submits that since the prosecution has failed to prove the case of the complainant and therefore, an attempt is being made to adduce such evidence by way of moving an application under Section 311 Cr.P.C which is annexed as Annexure P-9. She states that the said application has been decided on 16.10.2019, however, a copy of the said order has not been made available to her.

It is also not disputed by petitioner that previously she had filed petition bearing No.CRM-M-6553-2017 for quashing of FIR, however, the same was withdrawn on 28.02.2017.

Considering the above, this Court does not find any reason to invoke the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing of FIR. However, it shall be open for the petitioner to challenge the order (if any) passed on the application under Section 311 Cr.P.C against her.
