HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The petitioner is an accused in Criminal Complaint No.CIS/1095/2018 titled Yes Bank Limited vs. Sunil Amarlal Chawla and others, under Section 138/142 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

The petitioner is aggrieved of the orders dated 16.09.2019 and 25.09.2019, passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Gurugram (Annexure P-8), whereby, he has been declared as proclaimed person and his bank account has been directed to be attached.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there was no intention on part of the petitioner to evade the proceedings of law. The petitioner is a resident of Bombay, whereas the complaint is pending at Gurugram. He states that non-appearance of the petitioner was not intentional and he is willing to surrender before the Court and face trial.

Having considered the facts and circumstances, it is ordered that the petitioner may appear before the trial Court on or before 11.11.2019 or

any other date convenient to the trial Court. On his doing so, trial Court shall release him on bail to its satisfaction. He shall continue to attend the Court on every date of hearing without any default.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
