On 17.10.2019, following order was passed:-

“Petitioners pray for pre-arrest bail in FIR No.432 dated 30.8.2019 registered under Sections 306, 34 IPC (subsequently offence under Section 3(2) of Scheduled Castes and Schedules Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act) at Police Station, Shahabad, District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that late Raman had committed suicide and from the reading of the suicide note case against the petitioners is not made out. As per the allegations of the prosecution due to non-payment of salary by Advocate Kamal Sharma, late Sh. Raman is alleged to have committed suicide.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Manish Bansal, DAG, Haryana who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the State of Haryana and prays for time to seek instructions.

Mr. A.K.Kansal, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of first informant.

Let a copy of the petition be supplied to the learned counsel for the parties during the course of the day.

Adjourned to 16.11.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the

petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, who is present in Court, has submitted that the petitioners in this case have joined the investigation, cooperated and are not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 17.10.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
