The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.123 dated 05.06.2019 under Sections 489-B and 489-C IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Narwana, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of co-accused, namely, Rohtash from whom counterfeit currency notes of ₹6500/- were recovered. It is also alleged that recovery of 10 counterfeit notes of ₹500/- each has been effected from the petitioner. He also contends that co-accused, namely, Rohtash has been granted regular bail by the Coordinate Bench of this Court in **Criminal Misc. No.M-42747 of 2019**, on 15.10.2019 and the petitioner is in custody for about six months.

Learned State counsel contends that heavy recovery of 10 notes of ₹500/- each has been effected from the petitioner. He, however, is not in a

position to controvert the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner that co-accused, namely, Rohtash has been granted regular bail from whom counterfeit notes of ₹6500/- were recovered. He also contends that although charges have been framed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for about six months, co-accused has been granted regular bail by the Coordinate Bench of this Court and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take sometime, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
