TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA J.(Oral)

As per pleadings on record petitioner submitted an application for allotment of a retail outlet dealership under the SC Category at Jalandhar City under the Indian Oil Corporation Limited.

Petitioner is presently aggrieved of the communication dated 13.05.2019 (Annexure P-10) whereby she has been held to be ineligible for the RO dealership on the basis of documents submitted by her.

Mr. R.D. Anand, learned counsel would contend that the only deficiency insofar as the petitioner is concerned is of having submitted a wrong Pan number in the online application. Further urged that immediately after submission of the application online a representation had been submitted pointing out the inadvertent error and necessary rectification thereof had been prayed. It is contended that under such circumstances holding the petitioner to be ineligible cannot sustain.

Since an advance copy of the writ paper-book had already been served upon the respondent-Indian Oil Corporation Limited, Mr. Ashish

Kapoor, Advocate has entered appearance and has apprised the Court that correction in Pan number details is now being considered as a rectifiable deficiency. He further submits that the case of the petitioner is under re-consideration and a final view in the matter would be taken shortly and in any case within a period of four weeks from today.

In view of the above, there would be no need to examine the validity of the impugned communication dated 13.05.2019 (Annexure P-10) at this stage.

Writ petition is disposed of.

Needless to observe that it would always be open for the petitioner to seek legal redress in accordance with law, in the eventuality of any order being passed which may be construed as detrimental to her interest.
