Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.311 dated 15.08.2019 under Sections 365, 452, 511 IPC, registered at Police Station Rania, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is in custody since 18.08.2019. The alleged incident has taken place during the intervening night of 12/13.08.2019. As per the FIR, the petitioner has made an attempt to kidnap the minor daughter of the complainant. However, when the victim cried, hearing the noise of the victim, the complainant apprehended the petitioner. He has further argued that challan in the case has been presented on 08.09.2019 and no witness has been examined so far. Hence, trial in the case is not likely to be concluded in the near future.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Kamal Singh, does not dispute the custody period. However, he states that the petitioner has made an attempt to kidnap minor daughter of the complainant. On hearing noise of the victim, the complainant apprehended him, but he managed to run away and took shelter in the house of Master Joga Singh.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner is in custody since 18.08.2019 and trial is not likely to be concluded in the near future, coupled with the fact that no prosecution witness has been examined so far, this Court deems it appropriate to admit the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
