The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned transfer order dated 13.09.2019 (Annexures P-6) by which the petitioner has been transferred from Government Senior Secondary School, Pili Mandori, Block Bhattu Kalan, District Fatehabad to Government Senior Secondary School, Baghpur Block Palwal, District Palwal and also for staying the relieving order (Annexure P-7).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner will be satisfied if the present writ petition be treated as representation and a direction is issued to respondent no.2, Director School Education Haryana, Shiksha Sadan, Sector 5, Panchkula to consider the same, within a stipulated period.

Without going into the merits and demerits of the claim of the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent no.2, to treat the present writ petition as representation and consider the same within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and shall pass a

failing which, respondent no.2 shall be liable to pay costs of ₹ 25,000/- to petitioner.

This condition of imposing costs is only to prevent petitioner to run from pillar to post and avail remedy of contempt in case of non-compliance of directions issued by this Court.

The writ petition stands disposed of with the above direction.
