Petitioner-husband has filed the present revision petition impugning the order dated 17.09.2019 passed by the learned Principal Judge (Family Court), Ambala, whereby the learned Family Court had adjourned the case for 11.10.2019 for *ex-parte* arguments and thereafter, the case has been adjourned for 04.11.2019.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is ready to pay the outstanding maintenance, but in two installments within 2 months.

Heard.

The present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction that in case the petitioner appears before the learned Family Court along with bank draft of Rs.40,000/- within two weeks from today, with a further undertaking that he will deposit the remaining amount within 2 months from today, the learned Family Court shall allow the petitioner to join the proceedings.

The present petition is being disposed of at this stage without issuing notice to the respondent as it would not only delay the proceedings rather would put additional financial burden on the respondent for engaging a counsel in the case. However, in case the respondent is still aggrieved from this order, she would be at liberty to seek revival of this petition within one month from the date of knowledge of this order.
