In compliance with the order passed by this Court on 18.03.2019, affidavit dated 18.04.2019 of Executive Engineer, T.S. Division, HVPNL, Kurukshetra, has been filed in Court, the same is taken on record. Copy has already been supplied to the counsel for the respondent. According to the said affidavit, as per the interim order dated 04.03.2015 passed by this Court, circular dated 17.03.2004 has been implemented and work charge service of the respondent has been regularised for pensionary benefits vide office order dated 19.03.2015 (Annexure A-1). Arrears amounting to Rs.2,78,687/- i.e. difference of DCRG Rs.43,036/- and arrears of pension Rs.2,96,358/- (Annexure A-2 and A-3 respectively) have been paid to the respondent vide cheque No.407608 dated 21.10.2015 (Annexure A-4) after deducting a sum of Rs.60,707/- i.e. Employer's share of EPF (Annexure A-5) as per the Policy of the appellant and that too with the consent (Annexure A-6) submitted by respondent-Kartar Singh, Lineman. It has further been stated that the entire arrears as well as other benefits have already been released to

the respondent and nothing is due.

Counsel for the respondent states that she has not received any instructions from the respondent.

In the light of the above, the present appeal has been rendered infructuous and disposed of as such.
