On 17.10.2019, following order was passed:-

“Petitioners pray for pre-arrest bail in FIR No. 61 dated 22.9.2019 registered under Sections 323, 324, 452, 326, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station Kahnuwan, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that both the petitioners are attributed a lalkara. He further submits that the entire family of the petitioners is sought to be falsely implicated.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. S.P.S.Tinna, Addl. AG, Punjab who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab and prays for time to seek instructions.

Let a copy of the petition be supplied to the learned counsel for the State during the course of the day.

Adjourned to 16.11.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Raman Kumar

has submitted that the petitioners in this case have joined the investigation, cooperated and are not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 17.10.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
