Grievance of the petitioner is that the benefit for counting the previous service for the purpose of seniority and pensionary benefits has not been accorded to the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the judgment rendered by this Court in CWP No.2722 of 2013 titled 'Yash Pal Singh Rana Vs. The State of Punjab and others', decided on 05.02.2019 (Anneuxre P-9). He further submits that he will be satisfied if the respondents are directed to pass a speaking order by treating the present petition as representation and also by keeping in view the aforesaid judgment.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On advance service of copy of petition, Ms. Ambika Bedi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab has put in appearance on behalf of

respondent-State.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass a speaking order by treating the present writ petition as representation keeping in view the judgment, *ibid*.

7. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
