Learned counsel for the State has produced the bank statement of the appellant, which reflects that an amount of ₹47,718/- which is the arrears of the DCRG and an amount of ₹4,532/- as pension along with ₹2,75,704/-, which are the arrears of pension. A total amount of ₹3,27,954/- stands credited to the account of the appellant on 11.07.2019, which is maintained by her in the State Bank of India, Mansa Industrial Area, Mansa, Punjab, which fact is not disputed by the counsel for the appellant.

In view of the above, the orders passed by this Court having been complied with, this renders the present appeal infructuous.
