Order dated 30.04.2018 has not been complied with, in spite of three opportunities granted. The appellant-Sardar Khan had expired in the year 2015 prior to the decision of the Reference Court on 10.08.2017 and no effort as such was made to bring on record his legal heirs. Vide CM-1537-CI-2018 filed for bringing on record his legal heirs, the female members of the family have been excluded and it was on that account time had been sought to file appropriate affidavit in respect to the said application, which has not been filed.

Resultantly, this Court is of the opinion that the application as such is not liable to be allowed for bringing on record the legal heirs of the deceased Sardar Khan by excluding the female members of the family. The application is, accordingly, dismissed. Resultantly, the appeal is also dismissed.
