Petitioner herein seeks direction to the respondents to issue appointment letter to the petitioner and to allow him to join duty. The petitioner secured 59 marks in the written test and was allotted SB Rank SL/12713. The petitioner was also medically examined in BDF Badhmer and he was found medically fit.

2. The petitioner caused legal notice dated 19.08.2019 (Annexure P-5), but the same has not been adverted by the respondents. Hence the present petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ashish Rawal, Standing Counsel for Union of India has put in appearance on behalf of respondent-Union of India.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or

pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the legal notice dated 19.08.2019 (Annexure P-5) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done within a period of 60 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
