Petitioner-Kashmir Singh @ Raja has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.127 dated 06.06.2019 registered under Sections 307 and 148 read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code (Sections 452, 323 IPC added later on) and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar Rural, Amritsar.

The FIR was registered on the statement of complainant, namely, Gurpreet Singh wherein it was alleged that on 05.06.2019, when he along with his wife was present at his in-laws house, then Ajju, Tarlochan Singh, Dilbagh Singh, Jaswinder Singh, Mony and 5-6 other unknown persons who were armed with revolver and pistols came in two cars. They forcibly entered the house and inquired about complainant's father-in-law, who was not present at the house. When complainant and his brother-in-law

protested, then they gave pistol blow on complainant's head. Then Raja fired in the air in front of the house of the complainant's in-laws and ran away. On these broad allegations, FIR was registered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. He further invited the attention of the Court to compromise (Annexure P-3) arrived at between the complainant and all accused persons including the petitioner.

On the other hand, learned State counsel has opposed the prayer on the ground that the petitioner is named in the FIR who was armed with revolver and fired in the air.

Considering the nature of offence, no significance can be attached to the compromise, therefore, this Court does not find any valid reason for grant of extra ordinary concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition is dismissed.
