Petitioner had filed the instant petition seeking a Mandamus for directing the respondents to decide the issue regarding electricity bill dated 10.11.2011 amounting to Rs.31,715/- as also electricity bill dated 16.12.2011 amounting to Rs.34,275/- and which was pending adjudication before the Dispute Settlement Committee under the respondent-Corporation.

Learned counsel representing the respondent-Corporation apprises the Court that the Dispute Settlement Committee has since taken a final view in the matter and undertakes that the order that has been passed by the Committee would be communicated to the petitioner within a period of 7 days from today, if, not already so done.
