The petitioner made a complaint in relation to certain alleged activities by Masih Hospital, Sarojini Nagar, Yamuna Nagar, which is not even impleaded as a party to the writ petition. The said activities are stated to be in violation of the Pre-conception and Pre-natal Diagnostic Techniques (Prohibition of Sex Selection) Act, 1994. His complaint presently is that no action is being taken thereon. The pleadings however do not disclose as to what interest the petitioner has in the matter. In the event, the petitioner is acting in public interest, he necessarily has to file a public interest litigation in accordance with the rules framed by this Court.

The writ petition is utterly misconceived and is accordingly dismissed on this short ground. This order shall however not preclude the petitioner from filing a public interest litigation, if he so desires, as per law.
