On 22.10.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.83, dated 01.09.2019, registered under Section 420 IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Prevention of Human Smuggling Act, 2012, at Police Station Kotwali, Nabha, District Patiala.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, it is considered appropriate to direct the petitioner to join investigation.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under

Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Adjourned to 31.10.2019.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Nazar Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 22.10.2019 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
