Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.104, dated 05.07.2019, registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Fategarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

As per the allegations, petitioner was found in conscious possession of 10 Buprenorphine injections, 2ml each and 10 injections of Avil, 10 ml each. It is undisputed that Avil injections do not contain any narcotic or psychotropic substance as notified under the Act. Total quantity, even if the entire is taken into consideration, comes to 20 ml Buprenorphine injections. The commercial starts from more than 20 ml. He is not involved in any other case. Petitioner is in custody for 3 months and 15 days. Investigations are complete.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody for 3 months and 15 days and the trial of the case is likely to take long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate surety to the

satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly the petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
