Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.17, dated 14.02.2018, registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar.

In the considered view of this court, present petition in the form it has been filed is not maintainable, however, on the oral request of counsel for the petitioner, this petition is treated as one filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Petitioner is an accused facing trial for conscious possession of 70 intoxicant tablets. Petitioner was granted concession of bail, however on 30.05.2019, petitioner could not appear as he was arrested in a theft case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that if the petitioner is granted one opportunity, he shall surrender before the trial court and file fresh bail bonds with surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the trial court. He further informed that the case is now fixed for 13.12.2019.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is disposed of by directing the petitioner to surrender before the trial court within 10 days from today and furnish fresh bail bonds with surety of like

amount. He shall also file an undertaking that he would never remain absent unless in advance his exemption from personal appearance has been granted.

This order is conditional, subject to compliance of the aforesaid.
