For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and the delay of 11 days in filing of the appeal is condoned.

Main Cases

After arguing at length, learned counsel for the parties agree that both the appeals can be disposed of with a direction to the Sikh Gurdwara Judicial Commission, Amritsar to decide the petition under Section 142 of The Sikh Gurdwaras Act, 1925, pending before it as

expeditiously as possible preferably within a span of one year from the date

when both the parties appear before the Commission. The parties agree that they shall appear before the Commission on 30.11.2019.

In view of the above, the impugned orders dated 05.08.2017 and 06.07.2019 in both the appeals are set aside. The petition filed under Section 142 of The Sikh Gurdwaras Act, 1925, shall be decided by the Commission, within one year, in accordance with law, by granting equal opportunities to both the parties to lead their respective evidence.

Disposed of in the above terms.
