The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 439 dated 09.08.2019 registered under Section 379-A IPC at Police Station Meham, District Rohtak.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody in excess of three months and that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as charges have yet not been framed. The petitioner does not have any criminal antecedents and thus, he may be granted regular bail.

3. Custody certificate dated 14.12.2019 prepared by Sh. Sewa Singh, DSM, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison, Rohtak has been filed in Court. The same is taken on record. According to this certificate, the petitioner has undergone actual custody of 03 months and 10 days and there is no other criminal case pending/decided against him.

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4. Learned State counsel admits that charges have yet not been framed.

5. In view of the above, it is evident that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date. There is no other criminal case pending/decided against the petitioner and thus, no useful purpose would be served by keeping him in custody indefinitely.

6. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
