Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.78 dated 18.03.2019 registered under Sections 379, 411, 473, 467, 468, 471, 420, 120-B, 201 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sohana, District SAS Nagar, Punjab.

As per case of the prosecution, the petitioner after stealing the vehicles changes its engine and chasis number and dispose of the same.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurpartap Singh, has submitted that stolen 20 cars and 1 activa scooter have been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. He further submits that no doubt, the petitioner has been acquitted in 9 cases,

however, still 17 cases are pending including one case in Panipat, one case in Rajpura and many cases in Bathinda and Mohali.

In view thereof, this Court is not inclined to grant regular bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
