The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.641, dated 24.08.2019, under Sections 307, 323, 506, 34 IPC and Sections 25, 54 of the Arms Act (Section 30 of the Arms Act added subsequently), registered at Police Station Model Town Panipat, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that the petitioner is alleged to have fired a shot which hit the leg of the complainant. He also contends that the complainant and other eye-witnesses have not supported the prosecution case qua the involvement of the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody for over three and a half months and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Naresh Kumar, contends that 05 out of 21 prosecution witnesses have been examined. He, however, is not in a position to controvert the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner that the complainant and other eye-witnesses have not

supported the prosecution case qua the involvement of the petitioner.

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Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over three and a half months, he is not involved in any other case and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take sometime, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
