[1] Learned counsel contends that the petitioner was engaged as Computer Operator in DITS, Nuh on contract basis for a period of 01 year from 02.09.2018 to 31.08.2019. However, his contract was not extended on expiry on 31.08.2019 on the ground that his working performance was not satisfactory.

[2] Learned counsel states that the petitioner has submitted representation (Annexure P-5) dated Nil, praying for extension of his contract but he be permitted to file a fresh comprehensive representation and direction be issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation on receipt in a time bound manner.

[3] Without commenting upon the merits of the claim, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by granting liberty to the petitioner to submit a comprehensive representation, in addition to representation (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2 within a period of 02 weeks from today. On receipt of the representations along with certified copy of this order, respondent No.2 shall consider and decide the representations, in accordance with law within a period of 04 weeks thereafter.
