The applicant/wife, who is respondent No.1 in the divorce petition filed by her husband Bahadur Singh against her titled 'Bahadur Singh Vs. Satwant Kaur and another' pending before Principal Judge, Family Court, Moga seeks transfer of such divorce petition to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Faridkot.

I have heard learned counsel for the applicant besides going through the record.

A perusal of the copy of divorce petition, copy of which has been placed on record by the applicant herself, goes to show that there are serious allegations regarding the moral character of respondent No.1/applicant and it is specifically alleged that she is having illicit relations with respondent No.2 Lakhwinder Singh (Police Constable) who has been arrayed as respondent No.2. It being so, I find that it would not be proper and appropriate to allow the application. The same stands dismissed.
