The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.64 dated 10.09.2019 registered under Section 21 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Kacha Pacca, District Tarn Taran.

The operative part of the order dated 17.10.2019, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that as per the allegations in the FIR, the police party apprehended Harvinder Singh and Sandeep Singh and recovered 152 gms. of heroin from their possession. It is further submitted that the petitioner was not present at the spot and his name surfaced in the FIR later on, on the basis of the disclosure statement of the co-accused.

Notice of motion for 26.11.2019....”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 17.10.2019, the petitioner has appeared before the

Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Dalbir Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 17.10.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
