The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 162 dated 16.09.2018, under Sections 379-B, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, under Sections 342, 382 and 384 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Patran, District Patiala.

On the last date of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that Paramjit Kaur had taken a lift on the motorcycle of the complainant and had invited him to her house wherein other women, including the petitioner, were also present. Then they had beaten up the complainant and taken away his mobile phone, 'Aadhar' card and an amount of Rs.1,000/-. He had further contended that the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

This Court, by the order dated 18.10.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer,

subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Manjit Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 18.10.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
