Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.1 dated 09.01.2019, under Sections 61-1 of the Excise Act, 1914 and Section 482 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Lambra, Jalandhar.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 17.10.2019, passed the following order:-

“ Contends that recovery of the alleged contraband i.e. 350 cartons of different variety of liquor has already been effected.

Notice of motion for 02.12.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under

Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from the police official present in the Court, has stated that in terms of order dated 17.10.2019, petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, interim order dated 17.10.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is also made clear that petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

Disposed off accordingly.
