The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.117 dated 12.07.2019, registered under Sections 323, 324 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later) at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur.

The operative part of the order dated 17.10.2019, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is possibility of some amicable settlement between the parties as the petitioner is the father of complainant Navdeep Singh....”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 17.10.2019, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Jasbir

Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 17.10.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
