SURINDER GUPTA J.

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.112 dated 29.8.2019, registered for offence punishable under Sections 399/402 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur.

As per the allegation, four persons, namely, Amandeep, Harpreet, Happy and Jasvir (non-applicants) were arrested at Hotel Dolphin when a constable who was sent to hear their conversation heard that they were planning to proceed to commit robbery on way to Dalhousie on arrival of the petitioner at the gate. The petitioner was arrested on 30.8.2019.

Learned State counsel submits that no recovery has been effected from the petitioner. However, the challan will be filed against him in a short time.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case,

the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Hoshiarpur subject to following terms:

a. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

b. In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In the eventuality, the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.

c. He shall not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.
