The present complaint sent by Sukhdev Singh by post to Hon'ble the Chief Justice regarding alleged illegal detention of his brother Baldev Singh was treated as habeas corpus petition.

On notice, State has filed reply by way of affidavit of Gurpartap Singh Sahota, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Attari, Amritsar Rural enclosing therewith statements of petitioner Sukhdev Singh and Baldev Singh recorded by S.I. Gurpreet Singh, P.S. Gharinda and report of S.H.O., Police Station, Gharinda, Amritsar Rural.

As per reply, on being summoned Baldev Singh had gone to CIA Staff, Tarn Taran without informing his family members due to which his brother Sukhdev Singh made applications/petition in haste to the authorities including Hon'ble the Chief Justice. Said Baldev

Singh was not illegally detained and after formal enquiry had been released on the same day.

In view of the facts and circumstances as mentioned, no action is required to be taken in the present petition which is disposed of accordingly.
