This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members as they are facing threat at the hands of private respondent Nos.4 to 12.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that the civil suit between the parties is pending and injunction in favour of the petitioner has already been granted. It is also not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner that no incident ever took place after grant of the injunction on 22.07.2019.

There is nothing to establish that the alleged threat is existing as on today and therefore, this Court finds no reason to invoke inherent powers

under Section 482 Cr.P.C. However, it shall be open for the petitioner to avail the alternative remedy in accordance with law.

Petition is disposed off.
