Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 82 dated 26.05.2018 registered under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station City Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner was found in alleged possession of 1000 intoxicant tablets marked Prolonged Release Tramadol Hydrochloride (Calvidol-100SR) and has arrested on the spot on 26.05.2018 and since then he has been in custody.

Custody certificate by way of affidavit of Rajdeep Singh Brar, Deputy Superintendent, District Jail, Sri Muktsar Sahib, has been filed by learned State counsel in Court today and the same is taken on record. It has

been brought to the notice of this Court that the challan has been presented and out of 10 witnesses, now only 5 witnesses have been examined.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
