Petitioner-Kabal Singh @ Kali has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.90 dated 27.05.2014 registered under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 Act at Police Station Jhabhal, District Tarn Taran.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner that on 31.10.2018, the application for exemption from personal appearance filed by petitioner was declined and the trial Court had proceeded to cancel his bail and forfeited the bail bonds. At the same time, non-bailable warrants were also issued against the petitioner. Thereafter, the petitioner neither moved any application for recalling the warrants nor expressed his willingness to join the proceedings.

The trial Court continued with its efforts to secure the presence of the petitioner, however, finally the petitioner was declared a proclaimed

offender vide order dated 21.09.2019. It is at this stage, the present application for bail has been moved.

After hearing the learned counsel and considering the conduct of the petitioner, this Court does not find any reason to extend the concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

Resultantly, petition is dismissed.
