It is not disputed that the amount due to the petitioner has been paid but only the dispute survives qua the interest of arrears of interest.

In view of the same, the contempt petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to take the final decision with respect to the interest to be paid to the petitioner and thereafter the said amount be disbursed to him within two months from today.

Rule issued against the respondent(s) stands discharged.

However, in case the interest amount is not paid to the petitioner, he is at liberty to revive the contempt petition and in case the petitioner is forced to revive the contempt petition, heavy penalty shall be imposed to be recovered from the Officer responsible.
