The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.157 dated 11.09.2019 registered under Sections 18 and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act at Police Station Ismailabad, District Kurukshetra.

The operative part of the order dated 18.10.2019, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the police apprehended the co-accused Sagar @ Shanty and recovered 98 gms. of opium. It is further submitted that on the disclosure statement of Sagar @ Shanty, the name of another co-accused Puneet Mittal has been surfaced. Thereafter, the co-accused Puneet Mittal was arrested and he disclosed the name of another co-accused Adil and after the arrest of Adil, in his disclosure statement, the name of the present petitioner – Sparsh Kumar Kansal has been surfaced.”

Counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that the petitioner is a young boy aged about 18½ years and his career is at stake. It is further submitted that the petitioner is a first offender and since his name has been surfaced in the case in a sequence of disclosure statement, the same are yet to be proved by leading the evidence during the course of trial.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 18.10.2019, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Narinder, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 18.10.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
