The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0093 dated 18.08.2019 registered under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 325 and 326 IPC added later) at Police Station City Rampura, District Bathinda.

The operative part of the order dated 18.10.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

**“Counsel for the petitioner submits that the injury attributed to the petitioner is simple in nature and is on the non-vital part of the body.**

**Notice of motion for 14.11.2019.”**

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 18.10.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Karam Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further

investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 18.10.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
