The petitioner has filed the present writ petition for stepping up of his pay equivalent to his junior, namely, Inder Singh Bhorla. During the pendency of the writ petition, keeping in view the statement made in the affidavit filed on 22.05.2019, petitioner has been granted the said benefit and order has been passed in his favour on 06.05.2019, a copy of which has been attached as Annexure R-1.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that though the order dated 06.05.2019 has been passed in favour of the petitioner but the benefits accruing thereof, have not been released to the petitioner so far.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that in case the consequential benefits of the order dated 06.05.2019, if any, are yet to be paid to the petitioner, the same will be released to the petitioner within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that keeping in view the undertaking given by the learned counsel for the respondents, he does not wish to press this writ petition any further and prays that present writ petition be disposed of having been not pressed.
