Prayer in this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.39 dated 17.03.2019, registered under Sections 304-B, 120-B IPC at Police Station Shimlapuri, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is a married brother-in-law of the deceased Anamika. The petitioner is husband of Neelam who has been admitted on bail by this Court in CRM-M-23745 of 2019 (Neelam versus State of Punjab), decided on 05.09.2019.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Sukhwinder Singh, has submitted that the deceased had got married with the brother of the petitioner on 08.02.2016 and she died on 26.08.2018, i.e., about two years of her marriage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the fact that co-accused of the petitioner has been granted bail and trial will take sufficient long time, no useful purpose will

be served to keep the petitioner in custody, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
