Petitioner-Maninder Singh has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing of impugned order dated 25.04.2014 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Batala, whereby the petitioner was declared a proclaimed person.

During the course of argument, it is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner that the charges in the case were framed on 12.08.2011. Thereafter, the accused Maninder Singh absented from the proceedings in the case and was later on declared as proclaimed offender vide order dated 25.04.2014.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court does not find any reason to exercise the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C particularly when the petitioner, who was well aware of the trial has deliberately kept himself away from it till date.

Resultantly, petition is dismissed.
