Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the appellant arrayed as defendant no.2 and respondent no.1 i.e. the plaintiff have amicably resolved the matter, the terms and conditions of which have been set to writing on 26.08.2019. The same is attached as Annexure A-1 along with CM-11513-C-2019. It is further submitted that respondent no.2-Mam Chand who has been arrayed as defendant no.1 in the suit, has no objection thereof. The said respondent-Mam Chand entered into an agreement to sell dated 17.10.2006 with the plaintiff and thereafter sold the suit property to defendant no.2 – Thawar Mal i.e. the present appellant vide sale deed dated 24.12.2007.

Learned counsel for the respondents affirm and verify the factum of the settlement between the parties and submit that there is no objection to the disposal of the appeal in terms of the compromise entered between the plaintiff i.e. respondent no.1 and defendant no.2 i.e. the appellant.

In view of the facts and circumstances as above and specific stand of the parties, CM-11513-C-2019 is allowed and this appeal is disposed of in view of the compromise dated 26.08.2019 (Annexure A-1), which needless to say, shall form part of the decree.
