MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.(Oral)

Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.105 dated 12.07.2019 registered under Sections 379-B and 411 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station A Division Amritsar, District Amritsar City.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since, 12.07.2019 and as per the allegation of the prosecution itself he was chased and apprehended on the spot, but he has not been named in the FIR. Also contends that after investigation in the matter report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been submitted on 10.09.2019 and charges are yet to be framed. Further contends that there is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner.

The above factual position is duly acknowledged by

learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jaswant Singh.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the paper book.

Since the investigation is already over in the matter and there is no other case pending against the petitioner and he is in custody since 12.07.2019, the trial is likely to take a long time to be concluded and as such no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars any more.

Therefore, in view of the abovesaid circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. Petitioner-Gagandeep Singh @ Gaggi be admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.

However, it is made clear that above observations may not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merit of the case pending before learned trial Court.
